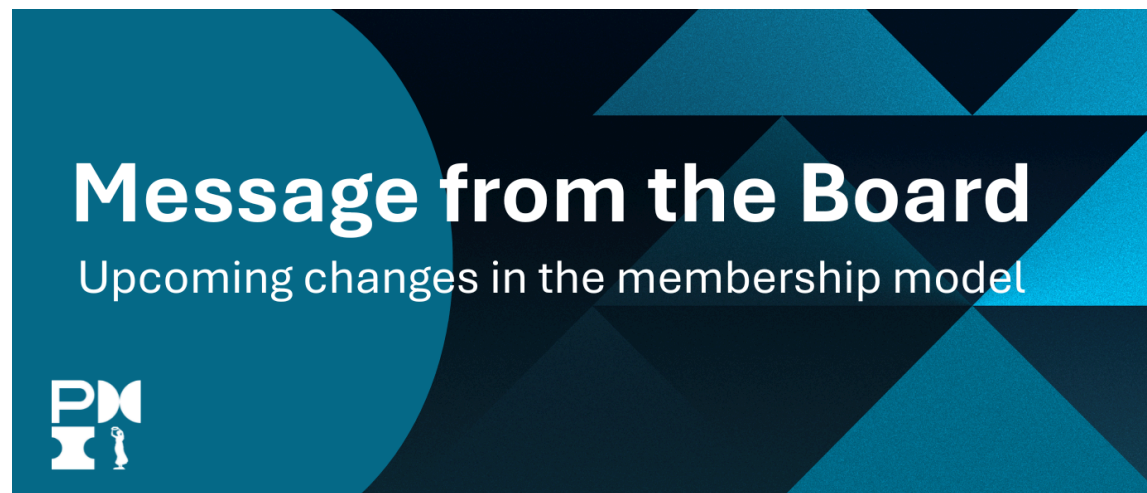

Dear Chapter Members **with the residence out of Luxembourg**,

With the **new PMI membership model**, all PMI members will automatically become Chapter members based on their address of residence. That is PMI's decision that we cannot oppose. That means that you, whose residence is out of Luxembourg, shall be automatically assigned to their local Chapter (France, Germany, Belgium - most of you are in these 3 countries) and will lose PMI Luxembourg Chapter membership.

These changes will start on **Feb 1 2026** and will affect all those whose membership renewal falls on this date or later. Members who renew their membership in January 2026 shall be affected in January 2027.

Those of you who had double Chapter membership (say, France and Luxembourg) paying for 2 Chapters will continue to do so. Your assigned Chapter will be France and you can select Luxembourg as another Chapter you want to be a member of. So for you, nothing changes substantially.

Those of you for whom the Luxembourg Chapter was the only choice will be affected. Obviously, you can opt to pay 2 Chapter memberships - your local and Luxembourg. However, if you don't want to do it - as you were not doing it all these years - you still may have a few options.

1. The cleanest way is to **change your residence address** to the one in Luxembourg. If you have a Luxembourg residence, you may declare that one in your PMI profile.

2. If you don't have a Luxembourg residence but work for a company in Luxembourg, you may **give the company's address** in your PMI profile - if your employer agrees with that.
3. If you don't have either of the above you may wait until the membership renewal and then, if nothing changes, **call the PMI Customer Service**, explain to them your situation and ask them to "geolocalise" you in Luxembourg. You may also reinforce that request by telling that you were always a member of the Luxembourg Chapter only and nothing else - the statement they can easily verify.

A Day of Ideas and Insights

The theme — **“Project Management in the AI Era: Bridging Precision, Creativity, and Innovation”** — perfectly captured the conversations and insights that defined the day. Together, we explored how artificial intelligence is reshaping the world of projects, while reaffirming that human leadership, empathy, and creativity remain at the core of success without forgetting the environmental and sustainability aspects. All the speakers were truly inspiring and some nuggets:

- Emotional Intelligence plays a key role in preparing for massive technological disruption. **Christian Kromme** – covering From AI and exponential technologies.
- **AI and Sustainability** can unlock untapped benefits for organizations. For example, 52% of organizations that have fully integrated AI into their sustainability strategy report improved cost savings, compared with 32% of those still in the exploration stage.
- The future of project management is hybrid. There are no purely predictive or adaptive approaches anymore. True value comes from tailoring the best elements of each to be fit for purpose - **Bart Briers**

Highlights from PMI Global Summit 2025 – Phoenix



We are thrilled to share some of the most important announcements from PMI's Global Summit in Phoenix (Nov 12–15, 2025). As always, this event was a powerful reminder of what happens when the project management community comes together under the theme “MORE, Together.” Our Director of Volunteers, **Saulius Kavoliunas**, was part of the PMI Global Summit this year to represent **PMI Luxembourg Chapter**.

Here are key takeaways and what's next for all of us in the profession:

Key Announcements

💡 *PMP Certification Exam Refresh (Launching July 2026)*

PMI announced a major refresh of the PMP® exam to better reflect current and future project management realities - including AI, sustainability, value delivery, and more adaptive (agile/hybrid) approaches.

- The exam content outline has been updated.
- A pilot for the new exam will be launched, giving early adopters a chance to test the new format.

💡 *PMBOK® Guide – 8th Edition Released*

PMI released the 8th Edition of the PMBOK® Guide, shaped by extensive practitioner input. This is positioned as their most community-informed edition yet.

💡 *PMI Infinity™ (AI Tool) – New Version*

The next iteration of PMI Infinity is now available — powered by multiple leading AI models, firmly grounded in PMI standards, and accessible via the PMI website and the mobile app.

💡 *Advanced Certification Pilot (2026)*

PMI is launching a new advanced certification in 2026 (pilot phase) for high-complexity, high-stakes project professionals.

- This path begins with an active PMP, then goes through peer review and proctored exam.
- It's being piloted now in select organizations.

💡 *Salary Survey Insight*

PMI released the new Earning Power: Project Management Salary Survey, showing that PMP-certified professionals earn a significant premium over non-certified peers.

- Survey respondents with a PMP® certification report higher median salaries than those without PMP certification - 33% higher on average across the 21 countries surveyed.

- This underscores how valuable continuous professional development and certification remain - especially in a changing world shaped by AI and hybrid work.

These announcements demonstrate PMI's commitment to modernizing project management - making it more relevant, future-proof, and aligned with pressing global trends like AI, sustainability and project success.

PMI Luxembourg and University of Luxembourg Partner on PhD Project Management Training

The PMI Luxembourg Chapter is honored to share about "Project Management for Your PhD" training program, a collaboration with University of Luxembourg designed to equip first-year doctoral candidates with essential project management skills for academic and professional success. Centered around the PMBOK framework, the course integrates modern techniques such as Artificial Intelligence (AI) for workflow optimization and Emotional Intelligence (EI) for leadership and collaboration. Delivered online over six sessions from late 2025 to early 2026, the program blends theory with practical applications, including group projects and presentations, fostering critical skills like stakeholder engagement, integration, and leadership.

Led by expert facilitators Mrs. **Aurora Gualtieri** and Dr. Claire Godet, participants gain confidence in managing their doctoral theses. Top-performing students will be rewarded with complimentary PMI memberships, opportunity to attend European PMI event, and platforms to showcase their skills via podcasts and webinars. This initiative reflects the PMI Luxembourg Chapter's commitment to supporting academic communities and advancing project management capabilities among emerging professionals.
